

Reviver Hardwood Floor Cleaner Instructions*

⚠ IMPORTANT:

Reviver Hardwood Floor Cleaner is meant to be used on Mirage Floors only. Do not use this product on any other surface. Store it in a safe place and keep it out of sunlight. Please consult the decision flow chart at miragefloors.com to make sure it is the right product for your needs.

Use Reviver Hardwood Floor Cleaner only when necessary. Always prioritize your weekly cleaning routine. This product is very effective at removing dirt from renovations, however, be sure to vacuum your floor thoroughly before use.

This product is not intended for use on a weekly basis.

Use it only when necessary, and no more than once a year.

The Reviver Cleaner is not designed for use in the following cases:

- Grease stains (cooking grease)
- Stains from household products left on the floor for long periods (mustard, wine, permanent marker, etc.)
- Adhesive residue
- Paint residue

1. Gently brush the floor using a Mirage light bristle brush. Brush lengthwise along the boards, applying light pressure to remove dirt.



2. Sweep or vacuum the entire floor. Check the decision flow chart at miragefloors.com to determine if you need to use Reviver Cleaner. If so, move on to step 3.



3. Select a 15-20 sq. ft. area and make sure you have at least 2 clean mop covers on hand before you start. For best results, the mop covers must be clean.



4. Spray a thin layer of Reviver Cleaner directly over the surface. Apply a sufficient amount to ensure the area does not dry out during the cleaning process. Leave the product on the floor for 30 to 60 seconds maximum.



5. Gently brush the floor lengthwise using the newly cleaned brush while the product is still on the surface. Use a back-and-forth motion to remove ground-in dirt.



6. When you have finished brushing your floor, you are ready to use the mop. Use one side of the mop cover to remove the dirt, working the mop back and forth lengthwise along the floorboards. Use the other side to wipe any remaining product off the surface.



Rinse the mop cover with fresh water and wring it out to make sure it is still clean. If not, replace the mop cover with a clean one. Always use a clean mop cover to ensure you remove all the dirt.



7. Repeat steps 4 to 6 as needed, depending on how dirty the floor is.



8. After using Reviver Hardwood Floor Cleaner, clean the entire floor surface with Hardwood Floor Cleaner using a new, clean, dry mop cover. Rinse it regularly with fresh water to remove any residue left by the Reviver Hardwood Floor Cleaner on your floor. Instructions for using Hardwood Floor Cleaner are available [here](#).



For optimal results:

- The mop covers are machine washable; do not use fabric softener during washing or drying in order to preserve the electrostatic properties of the microfiber and to not leave residue on the floor.
